



Disinfectants Approved for Use in Child Care Facilities

This list is intended as a resource for child care providers inquiring about disinfecting solutions other than bleach. Disinfectants are to be used on surfaces that are commonly contaminated with high hazard body fluids¹, surfaces such as, but not limited to, toilet seat inserts, diaper changing areas and any other surface that may have been contaminated with these fluids. Products mentioned does not represent endorsement by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment.

Disinfectants listed are designated as a hospital grade disinfectant, registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and the Colorado Department of Agriculture, and while not an exhaustive list, these products have a contact time of 5 minutes or less, and the instructions for use are appropriate for use in a child care setting. Using a disinfectant that is effective against norovirus is strongly recommended. Bleach, when mixed and used appropriately, is effective against norovirus.

The listed products are not approved to be used as a *sanitizer* on desks, dining tables other food contact surfaces or toys.
