

Colorado monitors influenza, COVID-19, and RSV activity throughout the year and additionally conducts in-depth surveillance each viral respiratory season between October and May. The 2023-2024 statewide influenza surveillance season officially started October 1, 2023 and runs through May 8, 2024. Currently, COVID-19 surveillance is conducte year-round. Both surveillance systems include statewide hospital admissions, outbreak reporting, test positivity data, and syndromic data. 


Hospital Admission Rates

Overall respiratory illness activity in **Colorado**




- This season is expected to have a similar or lower peak for the Big 3
- However, the peak will be much higher than prepandemic
- Vaccines are effective at reducing severity, hospitalization, death



Communicable Disease Epidemiology Changes, 2024-2025

- Transitioning COVID in nursing homes from CDPHE to ACHD CDE
 - 57 reported since 1/1/24
- Universal guidance on exclusion for all 3
 - Stay home until 24 hours after fever is gone and symptoms are improving




