


Geography

The Adams County Youth and Community Violence Prevention Action Team was formed in January 2024 to address upstream factors in Adams County that can help prevent violence. The multisector team aims to support and offer programming and services that promote health, well-being, and safety within our communities.

An area of focus for the Violence Prevention Action Team is South Commerce City*, highlighted in orange on the map to the right. This area differs significantly from the rest of Commerce City, with lower per capita income, higher poverty rates, variations in educational attainment, and a unique racial and ethnic composition. Notably, South Commerce City experiences disproportionately high rates of violence and related challenges, as reflected in data on mental health indicators, firearm-related incidents, and other violent crimes involving youth. This underscores the critical need for targeted prevention efforts in this community.
