#### PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING NATIONAL COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER

### PROCLAMATION No. 2025 - 007

WHEREAS, for over 60 years, Community Health Works (CHWs) have advanced health equity - addressing social determinants of health, providing culturally responsive care, reducing health disparities, and advocating for the needs of underserved and historically marginalized communities through education, outreach, advocacy, and support; and

**WHEREAS**, Community Health Workers (CHWs) are vital members of the healthcare and public health workforce, serving as trusted liaisons between individuals, communities, healthcare providers, and social services; and

**WHEREAS,** Adams County Health Department recognizes and appreciates the dedication, expertise, and compassion of CHWs in improving health outcomes, building stronger communities, and advocating for the well-being of all residents; and

**WHEREAS**, Adams County Health Department expanded its commitment to community health by bringing on two new CHWs in 2024 to enhance outreach, navigation, and support services for residents;

WHEREAS, the National Association of Community Health Workers (NACHW) established National Community Health Worker Awareness Week to highlight the importance of CHWs and to celebrate their contributions to improving public health; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2023, the first-ever National CHW Awareness Week was recognized nationwide, with nearly 80 organizations participating, and a Congressional resolution introduced to officially acknowledge the impact of CHWs on communities; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2025, CHW Awareness Week will be celebrated from August 26-30, reinforcing the commitment to raising awareness, fostering collaboration, and strengthening policies that respect, protect, and empower the CHW profession; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** the Adams County Health Department does hereby recognize August 26-30, 2025, as Community Health Worker Week in Adams County and encourages all residents, community leaders, and organizations to join in recognizing, supporting, and celebrating the invaluable contributions of Community Health Workers.
